Recruitment to two year Foundation Programmes August 2018: Stage 1


Outcome for Local Medical School Students

For 2018 the Peninsula Foundation school is linked to two medical schools, The University of Exeter and The University of Plymouth. The school also had some students who were still linked to the Peninsula College of Medicine and Dentistry (PCMD) after intercalating for a year.

202 PMS students were eligible to apply for the two year foundation programme. 10 students secured an academic foundation post and 4 students did not apply.

40 local students have a place in the Peninsula Foundation school. In this first stage of recruitment there are 2 local students on the national reserve list and 5 applicants have withdrawn their application.

Chart 1: Foundation School destinations of local students on the primary list



Nationally 96% of applicants were allocated to one of their top five preferences, 77% were placed at their first preference foundation school, and 84% of applicants allocated to the primary list were placed at one of their top two foundation schools.

Composition of the Peninsula Foundation School (at stage 1)


